The Ultrasound Changes Hearts and Minds

Sharon came to the Crestview New Hope Center with the intention of having an abortion. Upon arrival, she filled out our forms and went through her intake appointment. During that appointment, I learned quite a bit about Sharon. She was 22 and the father of her baby, Danny, was 20. It became apparent that she and Danny did not have a lot of knowledge about pregnancy, baby development, or the resources that were available to help them.

They both had steady jobs, each with their own insurance, but neither understood how that insurance would help them throughout the pregnancy, labor, and delivery, should they decide to parent. Sharon had recently purchased her own place and had a mortgage to be concerned with, and she felt having a baby at this time would be too much financially.

Danny had been a wonderful support in her life and a steadying force with her mood and emotion shifts, but she recognized that their relationship was very new and that they needed to grow their relationship before thinking about a family. Sharon wanted a future with Danny but starting with a baby wasn't desirable. She hadn't shared her pregnancy with anyone, especially her family as she feared they would be very unhappy with her. This was just not what she envisioned for herself.

We were able to offer her an ultrasound immediately following the intake. She was very nervous and anxious but agreed to find out if the baby was in the uterus and how far along she was. She laid back on the table and waited to see something on the screen. We could see the

yolk sac but could tell she was not very far along. Just a few seconds later, we heard the heartbeat, and Sharon broke into a great big smile behind her mask! Danny was waiting in the car because of Covid restrictions, but since we felt it most important for him to hear the heartbeat as well, he came in. Upon hearing the heartbeat, Danny said, "Whaaaat!" and was overcome with emotion.

We went back into the mentoring room after the ultrasound, and both Danny and Sharon broke into tears. I went on to share information with them about parenting classes and resources that we could provide, along with adoption information. We went through different abortion options, risks, and consequences as well as my personal testimony. They agreed to come back for a second ultrasound but left still undecided. However, they took a prescription for prenatal vitamins and a list of OB/GYNs.

Upon returning for the second ultrasound, they shared that they had made the decision to carry and parent the new life growing inside of her. Praise God! By the grace of God, they came to New Hope Center, and through Him we were able to educate and empower them to make a life saving decision. They are both taking parenting classes, learning so much, and preparing for the arrival of their precious baby.

Beautiful Letter from a Beautiful Client in Falmouth...

Dear New Hope Center,

My boyfriend, Eric, and I found out we were pregnant in December of 2019. I was clueless on how to take care of a baby, so I knew right away I wanted to sign up for parenting classes. I was referred to the New Hope Center in my hometown by a friend. I quickly became very acquainted with Mrs. Katie and Mrs. Cindy. Soon after signing up with New Hope Center, COVID-19 shut down most of the businesses in our state, including New Hope Center. For a new expecting mom, this was very scary for me, not knowing what the future might hold. New Hope played a very big part in my support system. Having to quarantine and living in a bad service area, it was very hard to find ways to still do my parenting classes. Mrs. Katie and Mrs. Cindy did everything they possibly could to help me find a way to finish these classes. Mrs. Katie and I stayed in touch via text and phone conversations after these classes.

In August of 2020, Eric and I gave birth to our sweet boy, Addison Eric. He was born 6 lbs. 20 inches long. Any challenges that I faced in the first few months of Addison's life, I'd look and think back on my class worksheets, and they gave me such great insight on how to overcome the obstacles at hand. Four months

after having Addison, I developed PPD (Postpartum Depression). Knowing that I needed to find something new to keep me busy, I reached out to Katie to see if there were more classes I could take. She quickly responded that I could do more parenting classes or I could do a 6-week Bible study. I chose to do the Bible study, and I got to fellowship, read God's Word, and pray with Cindy and Katie, which was a blessing. That Bible study helped me not only bond with God, but bond with my little family more also.

New Hope Center was my comfort zone during all the world's craziness while I was pregnant. I left New Hope Center with not only more knowledge of God and child care, I left New Hope Center with life-long friends who will always have a special place in my heart!



Q: What do you do when a Father Daughter Dance isn't feasible during a pandemic?

A: Create a Dance-in-a-Box!
