As I write this, we have 64 appointments scheduled this week. Women will be coming for free pregnancy tests and ultrasounds. Some know they can choose life for their babies because they are able to get the help they need here; some are excited but overwhelmed at the thought of having a baby. Some will be certain that an abortion is their only option, and it is our job to open their eyes to life-saving options. Families will come for closet visits to get the baby items they need. Mothers and fathers will come for mentoring and parenting classes, earning new car seats and cribs. Our SRA educators are in our local middle and high schools teaching students that “the choices you make today impact your tomorrow.” So many opportunities to make a lasting impact in just one week!

We are not going to rest on the successes of the last 35 years. God is up to something big at New Hope and He is expecting us to impact even more in 2024. How do I know? Because it is happening right before our eyes. Since the 1st of January, 46 mothers have chosen life. Two of those special mothers have lovingly chosen an adoption plan for their babies.

Real-life Impact in Covington

Kelly, one of the first clients at our newly opened Covington Center, came in for a pregnancy test and ultrasound. She wanted an abortion because her pregnancy was a result of a rape. Kelly was very open to talk about her options, even though her boyfriend and his mother were pressuring her to have an abortion. Her ultrasound revealed she was much farther along than she realized. As Kelly watched the ultrasound screen, she said, "It's a baby!" She took the pictures home, showed them to her boyfriend, and told him she did not want to abort her baby.

Angie, her mentor, shared information about adoption plans with Kelly. She wanted more information, so a meeting with Adoption Professionals was scheduled. They met with her and explained all of her options for adoption in detail. Kelly knew this was the best option for her baby and her family. She chose an open adoption plan and selected the perfect couple to adopt her baby.

Even though Kelly knew this was the right decision, she was very emotional living with the trauma of being raped. During one of her visits to New Hope, Angie asked if she could pray for her. Kelly's 2-year-old daughter was with her, and her sweet little girl held out her tiny hands to pray with them. Angie said, "It was a beautiful moment. Because Kelly chose an open adoption plan, she will get to be part of her baby's life and her daughter will get to know her brother or sister!"

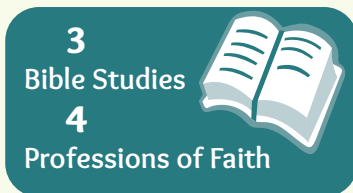
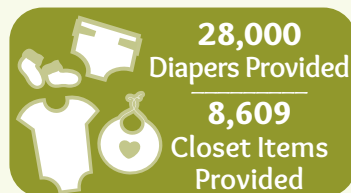
BABY BOTTLE BOOMERANG IS ON!



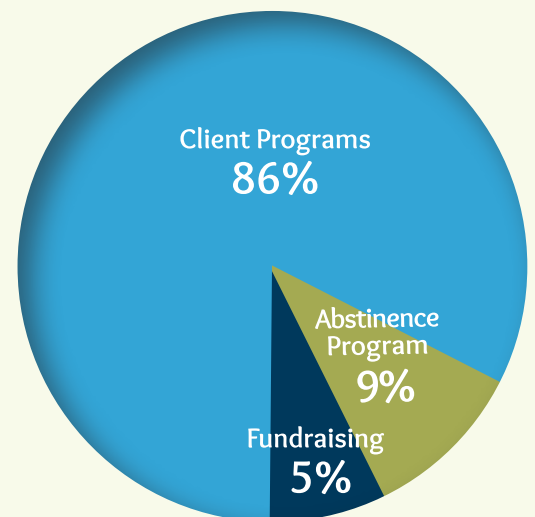
