

#### **35 YEARS OF IMPACT**

In 1989, New Hope Center was born. From day one, our mission has been to glorify God by demonstrating the love of Christ to all, ministering to the family as a whole, and meeting the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of those who are served while upholding the sanctity of all human life.

For 35 years, we have witnessed miracles, hearts changed, babies saved, families strengthened, lives transformed and God's kingdom expanded. From the moment those facing an unplanned pregnancy come through our doors, we provide hope by helping with emotional, material and spiritual support.

What kind of impact have we made since 1989? We have served nearly 15,000 moms and dads. Altogether, we have provided over 175,000 services and given out more than 1,000,000 diapers and 350,000 other material items. Over 100 clients have made professions of faith, 17 of which have been made this year! We have taught sexual risk avoidance programs to around 130,000 middle and high school students. 11 moms have courageously chosen to make adoption plans and 2 of these plans were finalized this year. *We have also provided over 2,143 ultrasounds*.

This month, we are so excited to have *four new ultrasound machines* to take the very first pictures of babies. Over the years, 87% of abortion-minded women who've come to us have chosen life after their ultrasound. These are not just numbers, but lives that have been saved and changed by the hope that changes everything.

New Hope Center's impact is ongoing and spreads beyond the walls of our centers. As a result of over 2,000 confirmed births, babies are celebrating their first birthdays, toddlers are discovering the world around them, teenagers are learning to drive, students are enrolling in college and adults are serving as first responders, social workers, nurses, teachers, business owners and in our nation's military. Others are Sunday School teachers, school volunteers, church ministry leaders and your neighbors and friends. Some are now parents, like Brooke, our very first New Hope Center baby. She is a mother of two beautiful children, and she is a social worker helping with resources for cancer patients and their families. She recently told us, *"I'm so grateful that New Hope Center gave hope to my mom at a time when she needed it. If not, I probably wouldn't be here and neither would my kids."* 

But we cannot sit back and rest on the success of the past 35 years. We have more work to do. In January, the beginning of our 36th year, we will be opening our Vevay, Indiana center. **If we are the first place women turn when facing an unplanned pregnancy, we have an opportunity to make abortion unthinkable, one person at a time.** Every life matters and we need your support now more than ever.

Performing ultrasounds at New Hope Center is so much more than a job; it is one of my greatest joys. It is a blessing to be the first person to introduce moms to their babies. When the bright image of life in the womb floods the dimly lit ultrasound room, it has the power to change hearts and minds.

"For you formed my inward parts; you knitled me together in my mother's womb. I praise you, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made." Psalm 139:13-14 Our old machines did an amazing job at imaging the heartbeat of babies as small as a grain of rice (around 6 weeks), all the way up to babies nearing the end of the second trimester; however, technology has advanced.

Through generous donors like you, we've been able to purchase four new and more advanced ultrasound machines. With

these new machines, our clients get to see a clearer image of the life God is knitting together in their womb. When it comes to performing ultrasounds for women facing unplanned (and sometimes unwanted) pregnancies, the clarity of the image can mean the difference between a decision to abort and a decision to carry to term.

God has blessed us with a qualified and compassionate medical staff trained to perform ultrasounds every day of the week at our Crestview Hills and Covington locations, and as needed at our Falmouth and Vevay locations.
