Sophia & Brad's Story

When Sophia walked into New Hope Center, her heart was heavy with uncertainty. She was seeking confirmation of a pregnancy she hadn't expected—one that shook the plans she and her fiancé, Brad, had carefully made. The wedding, the future they had mapped out—everything suddenly felt up in the air.

Tears flowed as Sophia poured out her heart. Though she and Brad were excited about their future, the timing didn't feel "right." This pregnancy was supposed to come after the wedding—after life felt settled.

During her visit, Sophia asked to speak privately with Jenna, our nurse manager. With gentleness and grace, Jenna answered her medical questions, reassured her that she had the right—and the time—to explore every option. She also stressed the importance of knowing where to turn for help if things didn't go as expected with an abortion. Sophia agreed to receive HopeSync videos, sent to her phone—honest and informative videos which walked her through the emotional and physical realities of abortion.

Then, Sophia met with Camille, our Crestview director, who shared her own experience with abortion. Their conversation was honest and deeply personal. Through tears, Sophia said, "I know that an abortion would be selfish. We're older, financially stable, and we have support. The timing just isn't ideal."

Camille reminded her that, no matter what, New Hope Center would walk with her. That assurance mattered.

A few days later, Sophia texted: "We have made the

decision to keep the baby." She also shared that Brad might need help processing the news, but was not ready to talk yet.

Later Sophia and Brad came in together—this time smiling. They admitted the past few weeks had been challenging. But now, peace was settling in.

Even as adults, they talked about how nervous they were to tell their parents the news. Before leaving, Camille and one of our married mentor couples gathered with them in prayer and reminded them that they were not alone.

Recently, Sophia shared their joyful news—they had welcomed a baby boy into the world. "We love him so much," she wrote. And in that one simple sentence, everything came full circle.

Because of your support, Sophia and Brad didn't have to walk this road alone. Their son is here today because they found hope, compassion, and truth at New Hope Center. Thank you for being part of their story.
