Walking the hallways of New Hope Center, I hear soft sounds—muffled conversations, a new mom’s laughter, the hum of the ultrasound machine, quiet prayers. In these ordinary rooms, God is doing extraordinary things. This is holy ground. These are the moments that remind me miracles aren’t just stories from long ago—they’re happening right now.

Miracles in our ultrasound rooms. A tiny heart beating... no bigger than a grain of rice. And in that moment, everything can change. One mother, tears streaming down her face, whispered, “I’m not going to keep my appointment at Planned Parenthood.” Hope overcame fear. Courage overcame doubt. Life was chosen. So far this year, 184 women have made that brave, life-saving choice.

Every child deserves hope and every parent deserves a chance. Miracles take root in our mentoring rooms where parents attend classes that equip them to raise healthy, thriving families—while earning essential baby items like cribs, car seats and diapers. One young father said, “These classes helped me become the dad my child deserves.”

Sometimes, we are a place of rescue. A young mother arrived bruised and terrified after a morning of abuse. We offered a safe space, support, and a path back to her safe family. She told us, “I think you just saved my life.” Today, she’s thriving, working, and preparing to welcome a baby girl.

Even in the hardest moments, hope finds a way. Adoption is an extraordinary miracle of love that creates a family. So far this year, one adoption was finalized, giving a child a forever home. Another baby was placed with loving parents. And several brave moms are now exploring adoption plans.

This year alone, we’ve provided more than 7,000 free services filled with extraordinary moments where women and men discovered they are not alone. They found practical help, real hope, and God’s love meeting them right where they are and transforming their lives forever.

So much has been accomplished but we have more work to do- expanding our Covington Center, growing programs and broadening our outreach of hope. Read all about it inside!

A Heartbeat that Changed Everything

When Jill and Tony first came to us, they were leaning toward abortion. Jill was deeply worried that her past substance use—both recreational and prescribed—might have already harmed her baby. Fear and uncertainty weighed heavily on them.

Thanks to your support, New Hope Center was there to meet them with compassion and hope.

During the ultrasound, Tony held Jill's hand, tender and attentive. As they watched the tiny heartbeat flicker across the screen, Jill grew emotional. The room grew still—and for the first time, they both saw the precious life God had created. Afterward, they met again privately with their mentor. Tony said decisively, "I want to keep the baby." Jill hesitated, then shared, "I guess I could try to quit." Without missing a beat, Tony replied, "I'll quit with you."

We walked them through next steps—connecting them with an OB/GYN and other resources. Then God opened a door for a spiritual conversation.

Their mentor shared the gospel through her personal testimony, and encouraged the couple to read Psalm 139 together. Tony was moved and wrote "Psalm 139"

on his arm to remind him to read it later—a verse that celebrates how each life is "fearfully and wonderfully made."

A few days later, we followed up by sending Jill a *HopeSync* video about substance use and pregnancy—an educational resource with short, informative videos that extend care beyond our walls, reminding clients they are not alone.

When Jill and Tony didn't return for their next appointment, we feared they might have chosen abortion. But months later, when Jenna, our Nurse Manager reached out around Jill's due date, we were thrilled when Jill said "We have a baby girl!"

We invited them in for a "closet visit", where they receive free diapers, baby clothes and other baby items. Jill replied, "We'd love to stop in. I appreciate everything you did for us and helping us make the right decision."

Because of your prayers and generosity, Jill and Tony's baby girl is alive today. Your giving helped them find courage, faith, and a future filled with hope.

Ways to Give and Get a Tax Break

Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) Owners of traditional IRAs, 401(k)s and similar plans must withdraw a specific amount annually beginning at age 73. RMDs are taxable.

Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) Generally, QCDs allow those age 70½ or older to make a tax-free donation from an IRA to a qualified charity.

Are QCDs and RMDs related? A QCD counts toward satisfying your RMD for the year but is not included in taxable income. If you're subject to RMDs, you can use a QCD to partially or fully satisfy your RMD for the year.

IRS Rule: To count toward an RMD, a QCD must be made first. You can apply a QCD to an RMD retroactively.

Miracles Happen in Small Groups

We're expanding our small group and one-on-one programs to help our clients grow!

MONEY MATTERS helps clients with finances. The 6-week class includes four sessions of *Making Ends Meet* and two with professionals on the path to homeownership.

FAITH FOUNDATIONS features a weekly bible study with videos, discussions, and practical applications that explore how God designed us for harmony—with Him, others, creation, and ourselves.

HELD WITH HOPE is a 6-week session for women who've experienced miscarriage, led by someone who's been there. Together, women find comfort through Scripture and shared experiences. Resources for men are also available.

MOVING FORWARD AFTER ABORTION is an 8-week session where women who've experienced the pain of a past abortion find understanding and healing in a safe, judgment-free space.
