Just as athletes rely on coaches, teammates, and steady encouragement to keep going, our mothers and fathers discover they are not alone. Hope is found in every conversation, every ultrasound room, every prayer quietly spoken, and every reminder that each woman is valued and deeply loved.

We see hope take shape when fear gives way to clarity. When shame is replaced with dignity. When a mother realizes she is stronger than she ever believed.

In 2026, we remain committed to being a place where hope is not just offered—but encountered. Hope that strengthens weary hearts, protects and saves precious lives, and reflects God's unfailing love long after the race feels over.

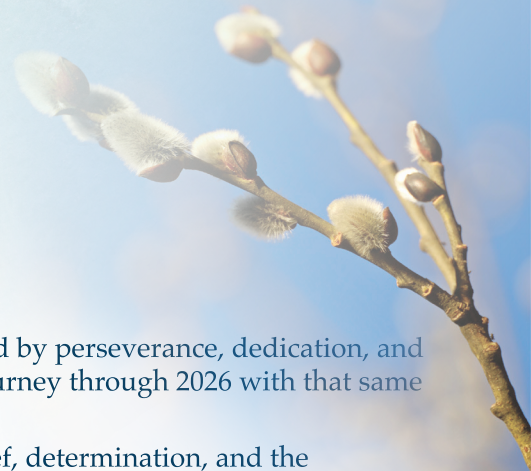

## From Fear to Joy—Thanks to You

Bonnie walked through our doors with an armful of donations and her preschooler in tow. She looked at our staff, glanced down at her child, and said, “New Hope saved my baby’s life.”

A few years earlier, Bonnie had called New Hope seeking an ultrasound before traveling to another city for an abortion. She wanted clarity—how far along she was—believing she could not endure a surgical abortion and fearing she might arrive only to be told she was too far along for the abortion pill. Our caring staff welcomed her that day, offering space to talk, to ask questions, and to be fully heard.

During her visit, Bonnie shared pieces of her story: recovery from addiction, a painful family history, and a cycle she longed to break. Once in the ultrasound room, the screen flickered to life. As she saw a tiny heartbeat, tears filled her eyes and she said, “This is amazing!” In that moment, Bonnie chose to continue her pregnancy and parent her baby. As she attended parenting classes, she spoke of her faith, once distant, now renewed.

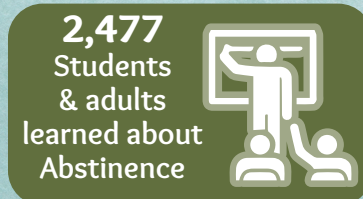
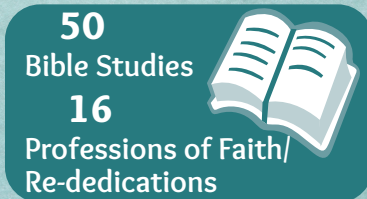
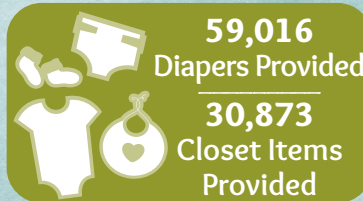

Because of our faithful donors, New Hope continues to be a place of compassionate care—where women aren’t rushed or judged, and where they don’t have to face the unexpected alone.

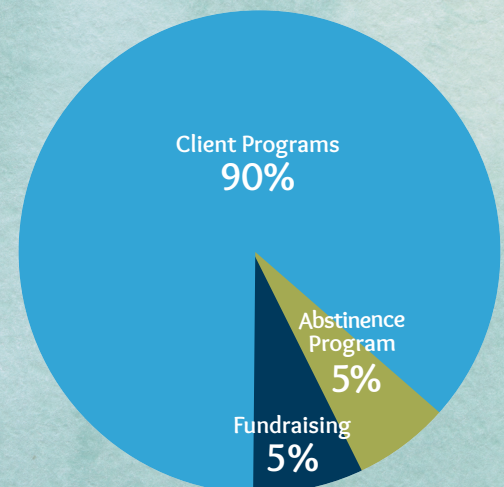
