## Strengthening a Father's Arms

Father's Day reminds us that pregnancy decisions impact fathers, too. Danny came to New Hope carrying deep grief from a previous abortion experience that he and his partner had never spoken about. He shared with his mentor that the loss had severely affected his mental health and left him struggling with hopelessness and isolation.

When they discovered they were pregnant again, they found New Hope—this time eager to parent.

Although Danny had not seen a healthy example of fatherhood growing up, he longed to be a different kind of dad to his child. Through New Hope's fatherhood program, he found something he had been missing—guidance, encouragement, and someone willing to walk alongside him as he prepared for fatherhood. Looking forward to his baby's arrival, Danny shared that he hoped to learn "how to raise a healthy baby/child into a happy adult."

By the end of his classes, he reflected on what had impacted him most: "The discussions with [my mentor], making sure I understand all of the subjects, and having a thorough understanding."

Abortion once left this father's arms empty and his future uncertain. But through compassionate mentoring, God used New Hope Center to strengthen his arms—and restore his hope—as he prepares to welcome his child.
