Make Room for Hope

Fall brings a new season—a season filled with possibility, new beginnings, and hope. But for many who walk through our doors, hope can feel far away. Every day, women and men come to New Hope carrying fears they never expected to face, looking for help and wondering where to turn. Here at New Hope Center, they discover they are safe, not alone and there is hope.

Pregnant after a sexual assault, Kelly came to us overwhelmed and believing abortion was her only option. But she found compassion and hope—not judgment. During an ultrasound, she saw her baby for the first time and whispered, “It’s a baby.” With the support of her mentor, Angie, Kelly courageously chose an open adoption plan and continued healing from the trauma she had endured.

A glimpse of hope in a story that began in unimaginable pain. A picture of what New Hope is all about: bringing hope into hard places and reminding families that God sees them, loves them, and has not abandoned them.

In just three years, God has used our Covington Center to transform hundreds of lives—saving babies, strengthening families, and sharing the hope of Christ. Through pregnancy services, mentoring, parenting education, and our partnership with Holmes High School, we’re reaching more pregnant and parenting students, young fathers, and families throughout our community, while expanding our outreach to Covington’s growing Hispanic community.

And now, our Covington Center has reached capacity—that’s a good problem to have! **The adjoining space is available and we believe God has opened the door for us to make room for more.** This expansion will provide more room for group mentoring and parenting classes, an expanded ultrasound room, and a dedicated nurses office. But this expansion isn’t just about adding square footage—it is about making more room for lives to be saved and changed.

Room for the mother who is terrified. Room for the father who doesn’t know where to begin and searching for direction. Room for the student who needs someone to believe in her. Room for the family desperate for help and hope. Room for another mother to see her baby for the very first time. Room for another life to be saved. Room for another heart to encounter Jesus.

HOPE Overcomes Any Barrier

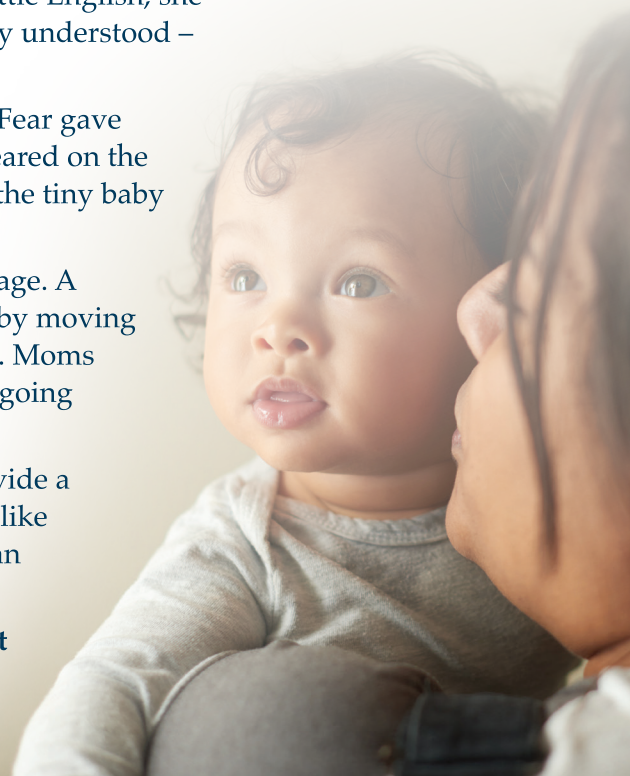
Tamara came to New Hope unsure if she wanted to continue her pregnancy. She spoke a language none of our staff or volunteers knew, creating one of the greatest barriers many clients face—communication. Through broken conversation, it became clear that she was scared and considering abortion. Though Tamara spoke very little English, she shared that she came to us looking for hope with a few words we clearly understood – “name New Hope” and “see heartbeat.”

During her ultrasound, everything changed. Tamara gasped, “WOW!” Fear gave way to wonder as she smiled. As soon as the scan began, her baby appeared on the screen—moving and full of energy. Then, in an unforgettable moment, the tiny baby appeared to lift a hand to its mouth and began sucking its thumb.

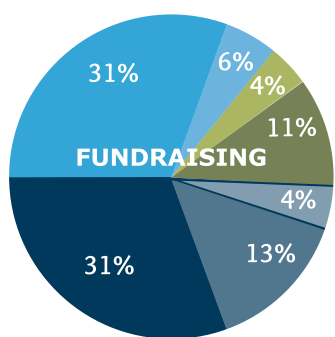
One of the beautiful things about ultrasound is that it transcends language. A mother may not understand every word spoken, but she can see her baby moving before her eyes. Yet outside the ultrasound room, language still matters. Moms need to ask questions, understand their options, and learn about the ongoing support New Hope Center provides.

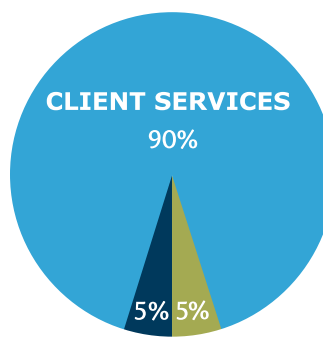
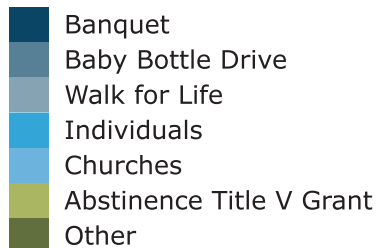
For approximately \$350 each (\$1,400 total), you can ensure every client who walks through our doors is heard, understood, and met with hope in their own language.
